The Positions

- 1700 hrs: full time service, education award of \$4,725*, living allowance of \$11,400
- 900 hrs: Part time service, education award of 2,362*, living allowance of \$6,035
- 450 hrs: reduced part time service, education award of \$1,250*, living allowance of \$3,018
- 300 hrs: minimal service (summer), education award of \$1,000*, living allowance of \$2,012

*Upon completion of service, members receive an education award in the form of a voucher. The education award can be used to pay off student loans or for future educational expenses
